MICHIGAN AUTHOR RACKS UP TWO MORE AWARDS

Mt. Clemens, Mich., Oct. 18, 2006 — Multifaceted author Nancy Feldbush won two Finalist awards for her inspirational Michigan-based historical novels. On Saturday, Oct. 14, USABookNews.com, an online magazine and review Web site for mainstream and independent publishing houses, announced the results of its fourth annual Best Books 2006 Book Awards, which attracted more than 1,200 entries. Feldbush placed among the Finalists and was presented with an award in the Fiction & Literature: Religious Fiction category for each of her novels, "To Repay A Debt" and "To Rebuild A Life."

The Award-Winning Finalist also earned three other honors earlier this year from ForeWord magazine's Book of the Year Awards. "To Repay A Debt" received Finalist awards in both the Historical Fiction and Religious Fiction categories, and "To Rebuild A Life" received a Finalist award in Religious Fiction.

"To Repay A Debt" and "To Rebuild A Life," the first and second in a series, are volumes in Moose Run Productions' The Michigan of Yesteryear Collection and are set during the upswing of Michigan's Victorian-era furniture industry.
